

OUR PAST: Since 1911, the Gateway Chamber of Commerce has been a steadfast advocate for businesses in Union County and beyond. Our legacy began as the Elizabeth Board of Trade, founded with the support of John D. Rockefeller and his Standard Oil company, which later became Bayway Refinery and now Phillips 66, was a key force in shaping the citiy of Elizabeth and the greater Union County region.

As the business landscape expanded, the Elizabeth Board of Trade evolved into the Elizabeth Chamber of Commerce, broadening its scope to address the diverse needs of Elizabeth's growing business community. Years later, recognizing the interconnectedness of neighboring communities, the Eastern Union County Chamber of Commerce was established to support businesses beyond Elizabeth, encompassing the eastern parts of Union County. This expansion fostered regional collaboration and economic development. As Union County's economy diversified, the need for a more inclusive organization led to the formation of the Union County Chamber of Commerce, which facilitated county-wide initiatives and policies to support business growth. In 2005, following a merger with the Central Jersey Chamber, we rebranded as the Gateway Regional Chamber of Commerce, solidifying our presence across Union, Middlesex, Somerset, and Essex counties.
